

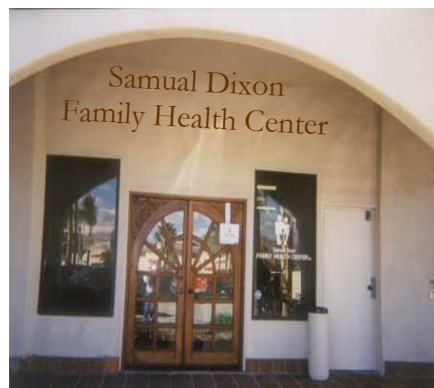

Our Mission

The mission of Samuel Dixon Family Health Centers, Inc. (SDFHC) is to enhance wellness by providing quality outpatient health care services and programs, health education, community resources and referrals. We want to ensure that all of our friends and neighbors have access to affordable, quality primary care. We make a special effort to serve the uninsured and underinsured.

2011: A Year of Change and Progress

As our fiscal year ended June 30, 2011, we look forward to major changes and progress in the new year in achieving federal healthcare status, expanding our care at our (still) new Newhall Health Center and expanding our presence in Canyon Country.

In the recently ended fiscal year, we made major progress in positioning ourselves for health care reform and federal status. We have applied for both FQHC and FQHC LookAlike status. We are resolving funding issues related to our Rural Health Clinic status at the Val Verde Health Center, thanks to Assemblyman Smyth's office for their efforts on our behalf in resolving complicated bureaucratic issues which had stalled our reimbursements.

We conducted a needs assessment of our area documenting the need for quality primary care in the community and identified priority areas for expansion. We have re-positioned our board of directors to better reflect the community and our patients and have begun initial thinking and planning for the development of a foundation to better focus and develop our fundraising efforts.

As health care reform continues to unfold, more people will be eligible for government funded health insurance programs such as Medi-Cal in California. This is good, but SDFHC remains faithful and focused on our primary mission of serving the uninsured and the underinsured. It is our belief that there will be still uninsured and underinsured and SDFHC is determined to have the financial capability to respond to these needs; thus, the need for a strong and energetic foundation board.

We want to take this opportunity to thank the Santa Clarita Valley for its great support through the years, especially with our signature event the Rubber Ducky Festival and Regatta. Media sponsors, such as The Signal, KHTS, SCVTV and others, have been particularly generous to us.

We would be remiss not to mention the ongoing support we have received from Providence Holy Cross through the years in providing literally hundreds of thousands of dollars in in-kind patient diagnostic care for our patients. Mission Valley Bank deserves special recognition in supporting and working with us through a particularly difficult period this last year. Thanks, also, to Henry Mayo Memorial Hospital and Kaiser Permanente for their continuous support and help. Thanks to the Santa Clarita Elks Lodge #2379 and the Rotary Clubs for their continuous support.

Lastly, we must acknowledge the significant and pivotal contributions provided to us this last year from the Henry Mayo Newhall Foundation and the Weingart Foundation. Financially we made a major turnaround this past year, but it would not have been possible without the foundation support.

SDFHC Highlights and Achievements of the Past Year

- ◆ 2010-2011 saw a major financial crisis for SDFHC, which “with the help of our friends” we successfully weathered.
- ◆ The employees of SDFHC continue to be our major strength. Without our premier clinic staff, we would not enjoy the patient satisfaction response that we see, the top marks we get in our program audits and the impact in the community that we want to make.
- ◆ We have always enjoyed strong board leadership and our past board presidents represent a “Who’s Who” of Santa Clarita: Tom Barnett, Steve Schmidt, Robert Veloz, Charlotte Kleeman, Adele Macpherson, John Frye, and of course our own Man of All Ages: Ed Bolden. Ed is now entering his fifth year as president of SDFHC.
- ◆ The Canyon Country Health Center celebrated 11 years of service to the Canyon Country residents of the Santa Clarita Valley.
- ◆ Patient volume continues at a very high level with patient visits averaging 18 a day, well above the Bureau of Primary Care standards.
- ◆ We meet and exceed national standards for cancer screening particularly for Chlamydia, breast cancer and for cervical cancer.
- ◆ SDFHC has been a participant in the bi-county LINK program which is a database of children’s immunization records, enabling providers to keep up to date on the status of immunizations of their pediatric patients.
- ◆ Family Planning continues to be a major program of SDFHC with over \$400,000 worth of services provided in the last fiscal year.
- ◆ SDFHC was the happy recipient of a \$100,000 matching grant from the Henry Mayo Newhall Foundation to ensure SDFHC financial stability to meet the needs of our patients during these difficult transitional times.
- ◆ SDFHC was the grateful recipient of a \$200,000 two year grant from the Weingart Foundation to assist SDFHC during these transitional financial times and to assure availability of the best of primary care in the Santa Clarita Valley.
- ◆ Positioning ourselves for a better financial base and to better meet the changing health care demographics of the SCV, we have applied for both FQHC and FQHC Look-Alike status.

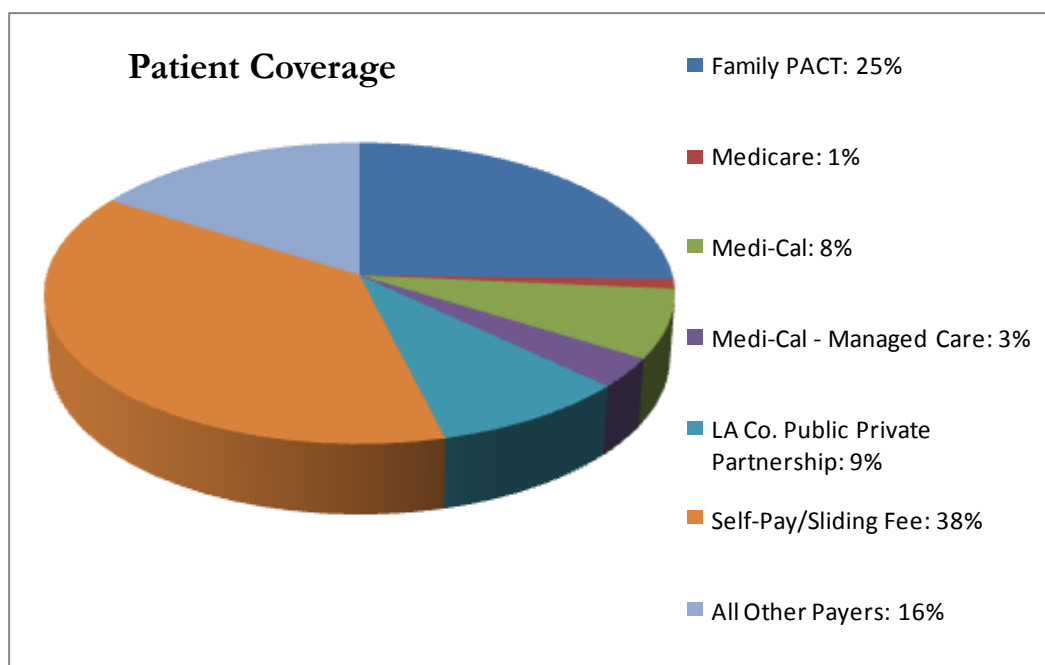

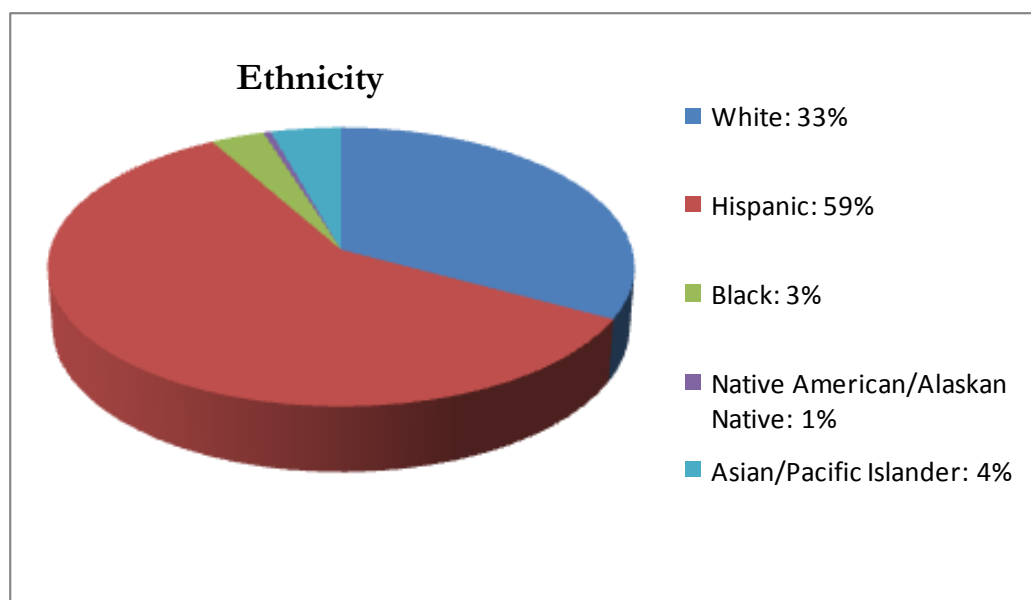

Who We Serve

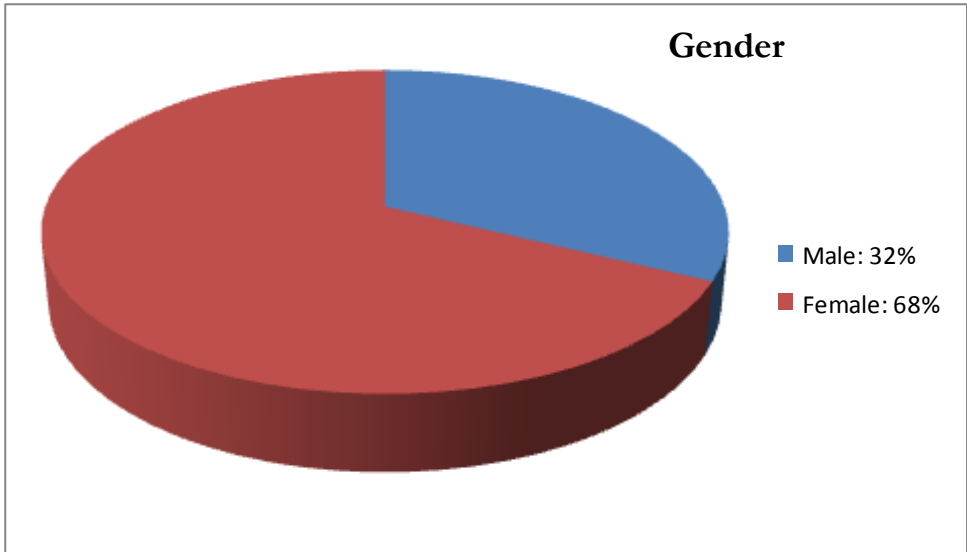

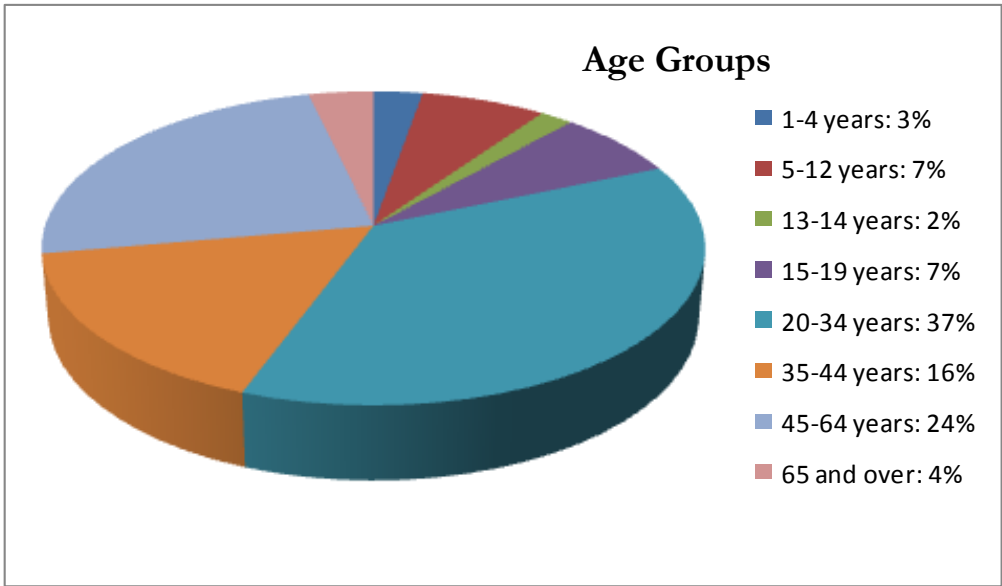
SDFHC continues to receive a majority of patients with little or no health insurance.

Strategic Goals

SDFHC continues to strive to provide the best health care possible. We plan to increase Medi-Cal Manager Care and to increase Managed Care membership.

In the future, we plan to develop an outreach plan for increased awareness of SDFHC. Our outreach plan is to increase community and service network groups of SDFHC as a primary care provider.

We will be incorporating a new foundation as fundraising arms of SDFHC by this coming December 2011. This means that we will transition charter foundation board members and develop articles of incorporation and by-laws. This will help to develop a financial base and should be complete by December 2015.

Further plans will be to own all of our Health Center sites and open an urgent care for after hours. Additionally, we plan to implement new EMR software and to maximize utilization of the Newhall site by implementing counseling and adding a dentist and two more providers.

Fundraising

More than half of SDFHC's annual budget must come from foundations or fundraising. SDFHC receives funding and is supported by corporate sponsors, foundations, and countless individuals who help make affordable health care possible. Tax-deductible contributions are welcome.

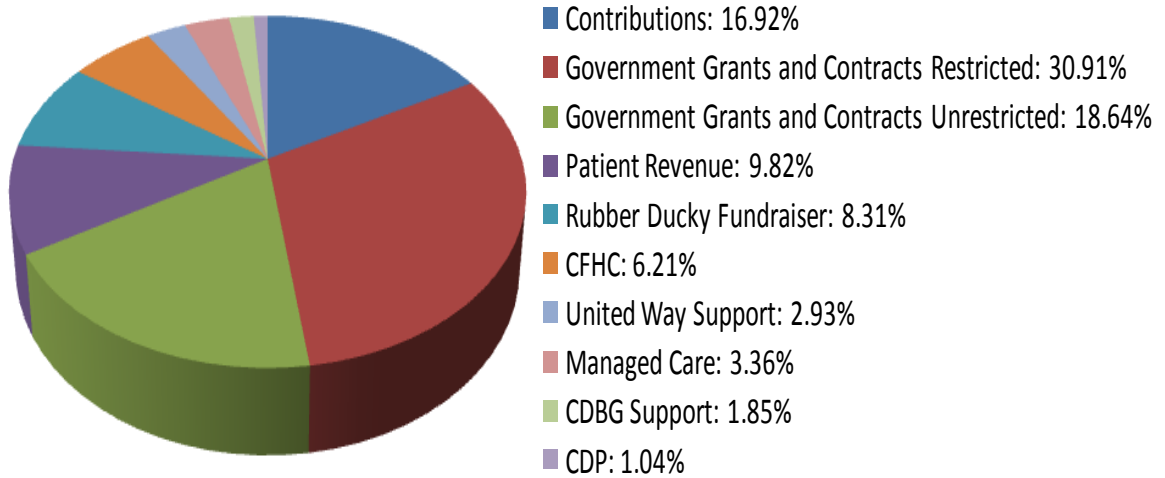

SDFHC provided more than 11,000 patient visits over the past year at our Canyon Country, Newhall, and Val Verde Health Centers. We provide a wide range of high-quality primary care services including: treatment of illness and injury, chronic care management, physical exams, family medicine, women's health, prenatal and well baby care, immunizations, and health education.

We also offer quarterly diabetes screenings for our patients as part of our chronic care management program, and co-sponsor healthy Women's Day with Zonta Club of Santa Clarita, each year. Through this prevention and early detection effort, uninsured and underinsured women are screened for breast cancer.

At California Institute of the Arts and College of the Canyons, SDFHC offers outreach health care programs for students. This helps us to broaden our patient population, and serve more people in the community who need our services. The addition of a physician assistant at CalArts has allowed SDFHC to expand family health services in the Newhall area.
